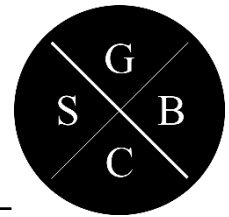


GOOD SPIRIT BIBLE CAMP

Staff Positions



Position: Speaker

Goal: To teach campers Biblical truths, especially the gospel of Jesus, through dynamic speaking and reading; to bring solidarity and organization to the scheduled teaching times, and to be involved in the spiritual nourishment of camp staff.

Remuneration: To be determined in conversation with the Camp Director. Mileage also available to a maximum of \$400.

Requirements:

- Have a strong relationship with Jesus Christ.
- Must possess strong leadership ability.
- Must possess the ability to communicate ideas clearly to different age groups.

Responsibilities:

1. Prepare short devotionals to share during the morning staff meetings.
2. Prepare approx. 10-11 Bible lessons/messages for the week, broken down as follows:
 - a. 5 messages for morning chapel sessions. Utilize camp staff as needed for skits, stories, etc.
 - b. 3-4 messages for nightly campfire time. Incorporate music, skits, stories, testimonies and sharing with camp staff as needed.
 - c. Prepare 1 introductory message for the first day of camp (Sunday evening), and 1 concluding/summary message for the closing program (Friday evening).
3. For child/youth camps: prepare discussion questions and scripture references based on each day's topic to be used by the Cabin Leaders during the nightly cabin devotions.
4. Spend time with campers and build relationships with them.
5. Be available to give advice and guidance to staff and campers as the need arises.

Working Relationships:

1. Responsible to the Program Director and Camp Director.
2. Helping cabin leaders and other staff in counseling of campers when needed.

*We ask all SBA churches to allow their pastors to speak at GSBC without taking holiday time. SBA pastors will receive mileage one way instead of a speaker's wage.
